- › Vocational subjects with high educational attainment outcomes

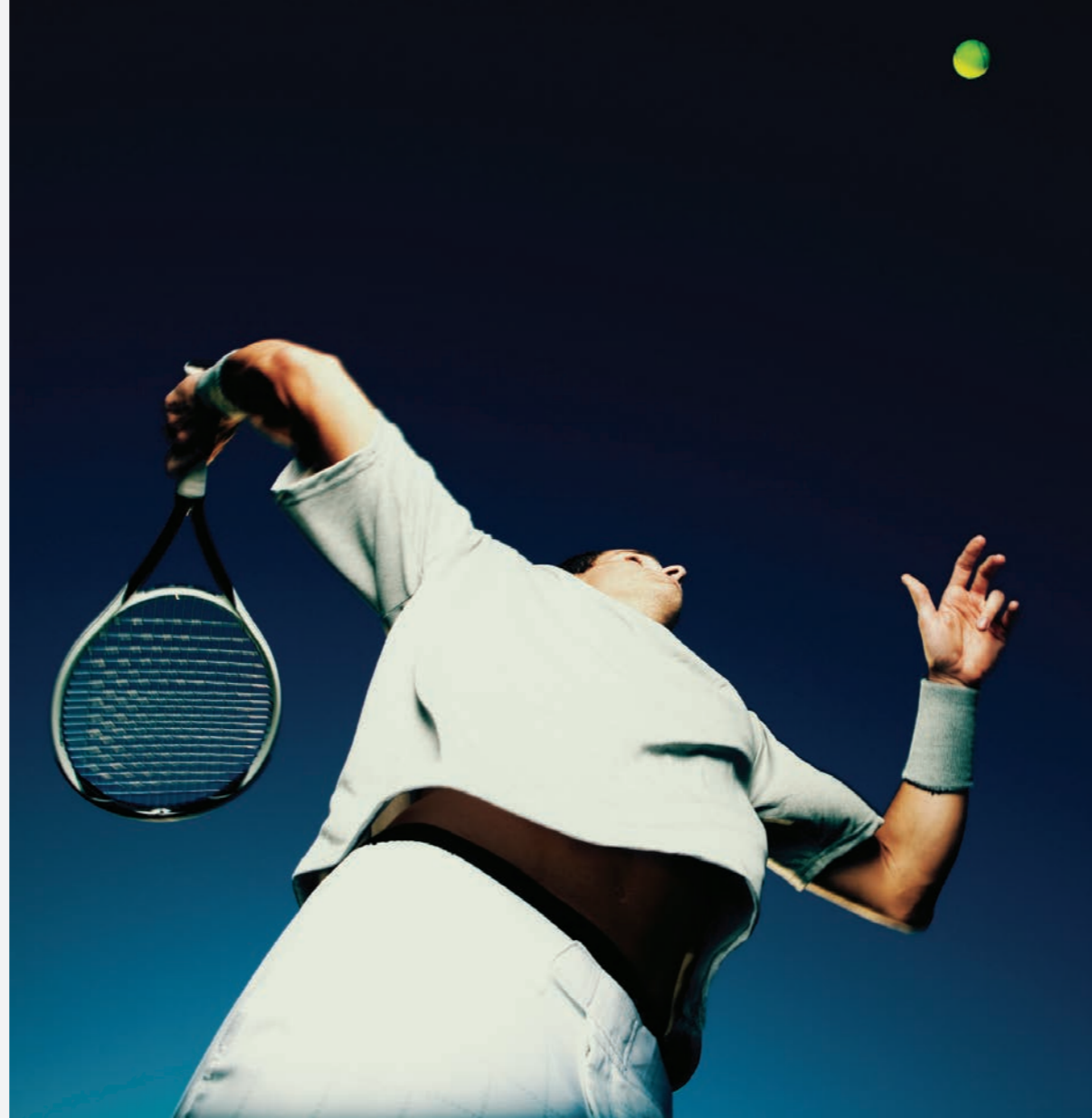


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# SPORT COACHING

Our VETiS (Vocational Education & Training in Schools) funded program is available to Queensland Secondary schools and their eligible students. With a minimum class size of just 15, CSF offers trainer led delivery onsite at your school in Sport Coaching & Sport and Recreation. These qualifications attract QCE points and provides students with insight into the Sports industry. They also include guest industry speakers, tours & possible work experience opportunities.



## STUDY PATHWAY

Study pathways enable students to obtain credit transfer to several universities. On completion of Certificate IV, Diploma & Advanced Diplomas level qualifications student may be able to receive credit towards Bachelor level qualifications.

## STUDY TRACK

Our objective is to provide graduates with the necessary skills and knowledge that will empower them to successfully fulfill the demands of the workplace.

Training is delivered in stages that correspond to AQF levels. The desired pathway for a qualification is for students to complete the requirements of the previous level qualification before progressing to the next level – thereby achieving more than one qualification.

## VETiS REQUIREMENTS

Students can undertake VET at school:

- > as part of their school studies - delivered and resourced by a school registered training organisation (RTO)
- > by enrolling in a qualification with an external RTO - funded either by the department's VET investment budget or through fee-for-service arrangements i.e. where the student or parent pays for the qualification

## ACADEMIC YEAR

- 8 terms - 4 terms for Certificate II in Sport Coaching / 4 terms for Certificate III in Sport Coaching
- 7 terms - 3 terms for Certificate II in Sport Coaching / 4 terms for Certificate III in Sport Coaching
- 6 terms - 3 terms for Certificate II in Sport Coaching / 3 terms for Certificate III in Sport Coaching
